

## **SIERRA MADRE POLICE BLOTTER**

During the week of Sunday, March 9<sup>th</sup>, to Saturday March 15<sup>th</sup>, the Sierra Madre Police Department responded to approximately 210 calls for service.

### **Sunday, March 9<sup>th</sup>:**

**3:16 PM** – Warrant Arrest, 500 block of Woodland Dr. Officers responded regarding an argument. During the investigation a records check revealed the resident had an outstanding warrant. The resident was issued a written promise to appear and released.
