After the parade on the 4th we'll have our traditional Community Picnic with the Civic Club's games in the park and *The Nightblooming Jazzmen* playing great Dixieland music from noon until 4pm.

I/WE AGREE TO THE FOLLOWING:

For the safety of the parade participants and spectators, **NO WATER** will be allowed. Be advised that **NOTHING** may be thrown by or from any entry. *******Candy may not be thrown by parade participants.*******
NO MOTORCYCLES; NO HORSES. Neither are permitted in the parade due to insurance restrictions. Motorized vehicles may be driven or operated by licensed drivers **only**. High-performance vehicles (race cars, etc) must be towed or carried on a trailer; engines of such vehicles may **NOT** be started or operated during the parade. Children under the age of 18 in the parade must be supervised by a parent or guardian.

RELEASE OF WAIVER AND ASSUMPTION OF RISK: (All participants MUST sign)
