Re: Petition by Natural Resources Defenses Council to Delay Permits by the South Coast Air Quality Management District

The San Gabriel Valley Legislative Coalition of Chambers, a regional consortium of chambers representing more than half of the Valley's cities, urge you to deny the Natural Resources Defense Council (NRDC, et. al., Petition to Require California to Amend its SIP Before Issuing Permits, dated December 10, 2009) last-ditch effort to block implementation of recently enacted state legislation (SB 827).

If granted, the NRDC petition would block issuance of some 1,200 South Coast Air Quality Management District permits for various small to mid-cap local businesses. This could delay and/or halt up to \$10 billion of Southern California new project investments. With unemployment hovering above 12.0% in California and 13.8% within two of the SCAQMD four county areas, the continued loss of jobs would further devastate the region.

Denying the NRDC Petition will benefit the environment in allowing the upgrades of older higher-emitting equipment with that of cleaner energy efficient modern pollution control technologies to proceed. Affected businesses include essential public services, such as hospitals, fire and police stations, sewage and drinking water treatment plants, as well as schools, food processors, gas stations and other vital local businesses.

The San Gabriel Valley Legislative Coalition of Chambers respectfully request that you deny NRDC's December 10, 2009 petition.
