Pete Siberell Sierra Madre's 2007 Citizen of the Year

Pete Siberell was born in Los Angeles, and grew up in New Canaan, CT and Hillsborough, CA. He attended UCLA, receiving his B.A. in Communications Studies, in the class of 1979). After graduating, he was in the advertising business in Los Angeles and San Francisco, working for Grey Advertising, J. Walter Thompson, Dentsu Young & Rubicam among others, with clients such as Princess Cruises, Westin Hotels, Goodyear, Vons, Suzuki Motorcycles, Hollywood Park, Bay Meadows and Golden Gate Fields. In 1993, he moved down from San Francisco to take a Director of Sales job at Santa Anita Park.

He is responsible now at Santa Anita for 1) working with the City of Arcadia and the community, 2) local and corporate donations, 3) the recreational facility and programs designed for stable workers on the backside of the racetrack, 4) use of the racetrack and its grounds for non-profit and/or community events and 5) use of the racetrack and its grounds for revenue events. ("The Shops at Santa Anita"), formation of a host committee for the 2003 and 2008 Breeders' Cup event (acquiring off-site parking, local transportation systems and more than 300 volunteers) and the coordination of the filming of "Seabiscuit" for a two-month period at the end of 2002 and many film, TV and commercial projects at Santa Anita, including "Bobby," "American Dream Derby," "Alias" and "Las Vegas."

He is also involved with various marketing events at Santa Anita. Upon joining Santa Anita, started the Santa Anita Derby Day 5K Run & Walk, one of the largest 5K runs in Los Angeles, which benefits the Arcadia HS Athletic Boosters Club and the Arcadia Historical Museum. He is a member of the Board of Directors of the Arcadia Chapter of the American Red Cross and Arcadia Chamber of Commerce.

But not everything Pete does is at Santa Anita and/or in Arcadia, and tonight he is being honored for the work he has done for the community of Sierra Madre.

Siberell has chaired the Mt. Wilson Trail Race Committee for several years, and has overseen major growth in the event. The Trail Race, which was once just a run up the hill, now includes a pre-race pasta feed the night before, a community children's art show, booths featuring information and product for the runner, massage for runner's aches and pains, and for the last two years, with the help of major sponsor CATZ, a kid's fun run up and down Baldwin Ave. Siberell has also been instrumental in bringing the race, California's second oldest trail race, into the 21st century, with the introduction of computer chips that monitor racer's time and streamline the tracking of the performance of the 300+ runners who participate each year.

Siberell has also taken on leadership of the Sierra Madre Little League, serving as President of the Board of Directors, and also brought it to a new level, with improvements on the field, such as new sprinkler systems, shaded dugouts, and a new scoreboard. Opening day has also been expanded, with the addition of game booths and bouncy houses for the kids.

He is a past Chairman of the Community Services Commission for the City of Sierra Madre (eight years), and a member of Sierra Madre Rotary Club. He plans to continue his involvement with City of Sierra Madre's Community Services department, helping to design scheduled athletic events to raise awareness of, and prevent, childhood obesity.

Pete is married to Marianne, a flight attendant for United Airlines. The couple has two sons, P.J. (11) and George (10), who both attend Don Benito School in Pasadena.

His interests when not keeping himself busy with all of the above? "Anything athletic and exercise-inducing, reading, opera and writing endless Sierra Madre Little League newsletters. Golf would be my be-all, end-all passion if only I had more time to play!"
